## HAZEN HIGH SCHOOL \* Running Start Participation Agreement

- Running Start (RS) students are subject to all rules, regulations and procedures governing college students for course requirements, content, registration, grading and appropriate behavior.
- Students are responsible for managing their class schedule between the college and HHS. Students should not schedule college courses that conflict with their HHS Schedule.
- RS is a year-long commitment; students should plan on making a year-long commitment.
- Students may enroll in RS for a maximum of 6 quarters (fall, winter spring) or until the end of their 12<sup>th</sup> grade year.
- Monitoring all RS deadlines is the responsibility of the student.
- All RS grades will become a permanent part of the student's high school <u>and college transcripts</u>. Families and students are aware that grades earned as a Running Start student can impact financial aid eligibility.
- Students are responsible for dropping any college before the drop deadlines.
- RS students must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA each quarter or be placed on academic probation which may lead to dismissal from the RS program.
- RS students are subject to Washington state and Renton School District graduation requirements. Students and parents are responsible for monitoring progress towards meeting graduation requirements.
- Hazen Counselors identify RS Verification Form Drop-in Hours each quarter prior to college registration. These are the only times RS students may have their RSVF signed by their school counselor. Students will be notified of these hours via email (the email student reports below).
- Other important details, such as changes to the Hazen daily schedule, reminders about graduation requirement deadlines, etc. will also be communicated to RS students via email.
- Students are responsible for checking with individual colleges/universities regarding the transfer policies for credits obtained through RS.
- RS athletes must meet WIAA eligibility requirements if participating in Hazen sports programs.
- The RS program funds a maximum of 15 credits of 100 level or higher college course credits per quarter (099 classes and below are not funded). All additional expenses including but not limited to books, parking, lab and registration fees, transportation, etc. are the responsibility of the student.
